
Reminder


Year 1 & Year 2Trip to Sandylands—Tennis

Year One—Phonic Screening Check

week commencing 10th June 2024

Thak you to all those parents that attended the Phonics screening check information evening. For those that did not manage to make it - the below information might help.


The phonics screening check is a test that Year One pupils in England are required to take.

The test is a statutory assessment that confirms whether or not pupils have met the expected standard in phonic decoding - and can reveal which pupils may need additional support.

The check contains 40 words divided into two sections of 20 words. Both sections contain a mixture of real words and pseudo-words ('alien words' - which are phonically decodable but are not actual words).

Teachers administer the check one-on-one with each pupil and record whether their response to each of the 40 words is correct. Each pupil is awarded a mark between 0 and 40.

Very grateful for your time and effort. Please pass that on to the children'.




Kíldwick Fell Race—Tuesday 21st May


