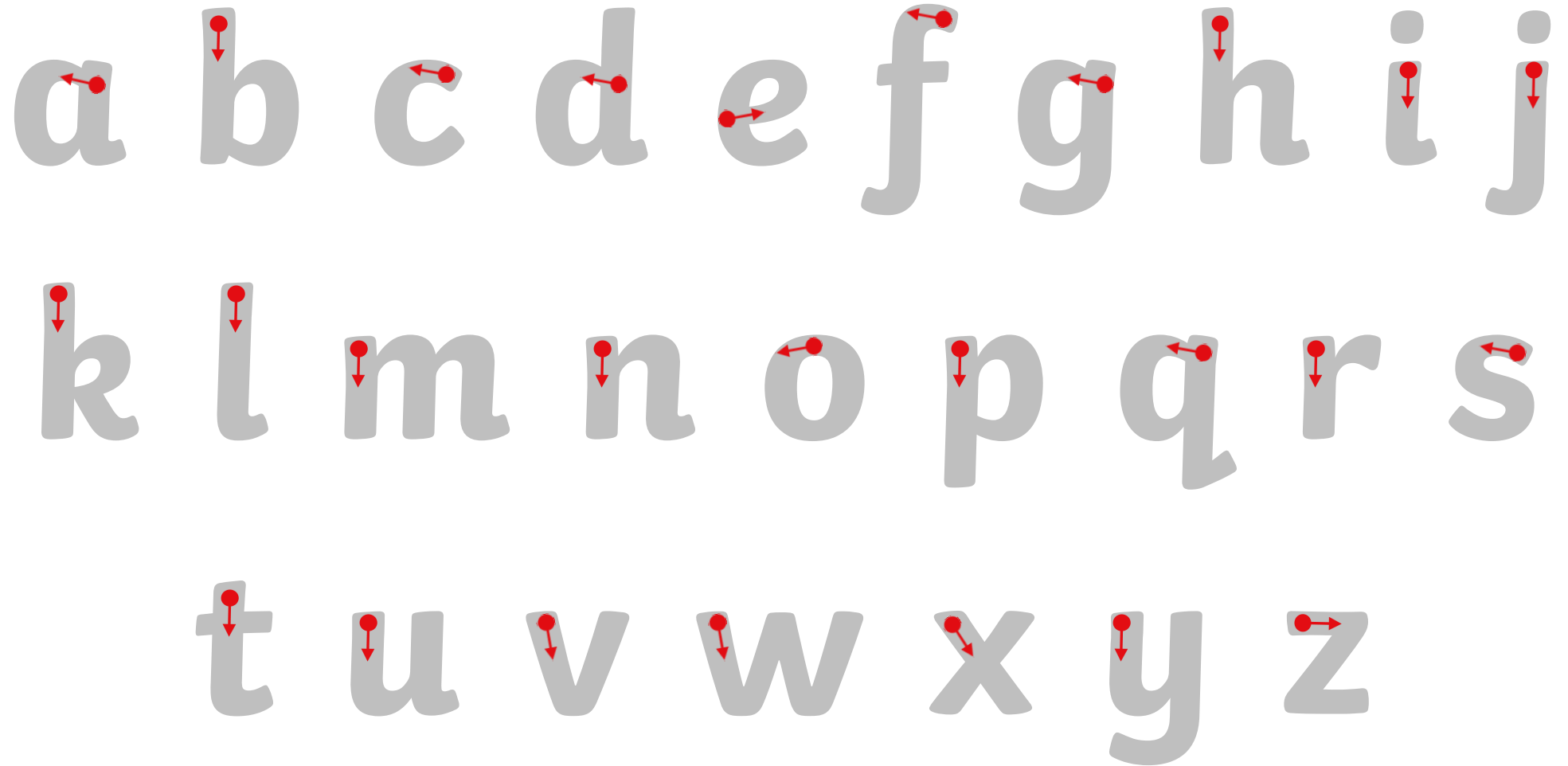


This is how we write our letters in Reception.



We do not teach letters using a lead-in stroke in Reception, as advised in Guidance issued by the DfE in 2021. However, we ...

- teach Handwriting to the children, introducing them to letters in their 'Handwriting Families'
- encourage the children to develop a comfortable pencil grip
- develop good postural and visual control
- develop their fine and gross motor skills so they are able to begin to join letters (if ready) in Key Stage 1
- provide print in books and our class environment which matches the handwriting style they are being taught
