

INTRODUCTION


In the spring of 2023 Governors sent out a communication survey to parents and other parties within the school community to ascertain parent views on the level and method of communication by Embsay School.











CHARTS

78% of parents are neutral or agree that the school communicates effectively.


You are happy with the volume of communication with the school






64% of parents think that there is enough communication from the school. 27% would prefer more, 9% would prefer less


Please rank the following in order of preference based on how you would like to receive communications from the school about news and events




Interestingly most parents preferred emails and asked for a Friday newsletter however their preferred communication method is parent pay. This was not mentioned in any comments from parents during question 6.




When would you prefer school communications to be sent?





Do you feel that the school provides adequate notice for events?




Most parents seem happy with the notice given for events however this was a common theme picked up from written comments in question 6




The majority of parents prefer to email or phone the school.





There are enough opportunities to talk to staff about your child and raise any concerns you may have?





What method of reminders (eg, for non uniform days, class trips, open classrooms) do you / would you find most effective?







Have you accessed the new website






Have you saved the app version of the school website on your Phone









Please rank the areas you access most?




Please select how frequently you look up different areas of the website






How would you rate the website out of 5?

Responses have been taken from the feedback and collated based on their theme for simplicity and to spot trends. Individual comments have been shared with the school's leadership team and Governors.






