

Half -Termly Topic Plan Year 1 Spring 2

Subject	Topic - Space
English	In English this half term we will be reading a range of books set in outer
	space and learning how to describe characters and settings in stories. We will
	continue our focus on sentence writing, thinking carefully about spelling
	choices – using phonics to choose sounds needed to spell. We will continue to
	focus on letter formation - forming letters appropriately and using lines
	accurately. Our non-fiction work will include writing questions and
	instructions.
	Reading: Reading books will be changed when we hear your child read. We ask
	books to be re-read to support the children's fluency and their comprehension
	skills. Please continue to send in their reading folder every day.
	Phonics: Phonics will continue to be taught daily.
	Spellings: Spellings will be sent home each week and assessed on Fridays. Please
	practise reading the words as well as spellings them with your child; encourage them to add sound buttons when writing. The tricky words (shown in bold at the end of the
	list) have alternative sounds which they haven't learnt yet so please don't add sound
	buttons to these. Please send books back for new spellings each Friday.
